March Topic Themes & Intentions

March topic is 'British Science Week' - All month! This is one of the staff teams favourite topics. We will be exploring concepts such as change, materials, forces and engineering through experiments, demonstrations and activities.

As part of this topic we will be taking part in the Great World Nurdle Hunt at Par Beach, on Thursday 19th March. (Nurdles are small plastic pellets about the size of a lentil. Countless billion are used each year to make nearly all our plastic products but many end up washing up on our shores.) All children who attend pre-school on Thursday will be visiting the beach. Any children who are not booked in for Thursday are welcome to meet us at the beach, with an accompanying adult, at about 10.00am. We have also invited our friends from Footsteps Childcare Centre to join us.
